

Public Notice

In-office voting for the Mar. 5, 2024, Presidential Primary Election begins Monday, Feb. 5 at the <u>San Diego County Registrar of Voters</u> located at 5600 Overland Avenue, Suite 100, San Diego, CA, 92123 on the County Operations Center campus in Kearny Mesa.

- The Registrar's office will be open for voting Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Starting Saturday, Feb. 24 the Registrar's office and thirty-eight vote centers will be open daily for voting from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Starting Saturday, Mar. 2 over 200 vote centers (including the Registrar's office) will be open daily for voting from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. until the final day of voting, Mar. 5 when the voting hours change to 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Voting System Logic and Accuracy Testing:

• Expected to begin Monday, Jan. 29 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., daily or until completed.

Processing of Mail Ballots:

- Signature verification of return envelopes is expected to begin Feb. 8.
- Opening and preparing mail ballots for tabulation is expected to begin Feb. 12.
- Ballot scanning and adjudication is expected to begin Feb. 23.

Voting results will be posted on the following schedule:

- After 8 p.m., Tuesday, Mar. 5 (following the close of vote centers, periodic result updates will
 continue throughout the night until all vote center ballots are reported).
- After election night, the next unofficial results update will be posted on the following schedule:
 - o By 5 p.m., Thursday, Mar. 7 through Saturday Mar. 9.
 - By 5 p.m., Monday/Wednesday/Friday, Mar. 11 through Mar. 15.
- Additional postings may occur at the discretion of the Registrar of Voters.

Please note the office will be closed on Feb. 19 and Apr. 1 in observance of county holidays.

All results are unofficial until completion of the official canvass of the election on or before Apr. 4.
