

**Public Notice** 

In-office voting for the Assembly District 80 Special Primary Election starts Monday, March 7 and will continue through Tuesday, April 5 (Election Day). This primary election is to fill a vacancy in the 80th Assembly District for the remainder of the current term. Voters residing in the 80th Assembly District under the 2011 district boundaries are eligible to participate in the election.

Beginning March 7, the office will be open for voting:

- Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Election Day, April 5, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The office will be closed on Thursday, March 31 in observance of Cesar Chavez Day.

Signature verification is expected to begin March 14.

Opening and preparing mail ballots for tabulation will begin on or after March 16.

Voting results will be posted on the following schedule:

- After 8 p.m., Tuesday, April 5 (following close of vote centers and in-office voting)
- After 5 p.m., Thursday, April 7
- Additional postings may occur at the discretion of the Registrar of Voters

All results are unofficial until completion of the official canvass of the election on or before April 14.
