1. WHY IS THERE AN ELECTION MARCH 19, 2019?

The California Elections Code permits jurisdictions to call for a special election to be conducted should specific circumstances arise.

March 19, 2019 the Julian-Cuyamaca Fire Protection District will have an election specific to Measure A.

Measure A: Proposed Reorganization of the Julian-Cuyamaca Fire Protection District
Shall the order adopted on September 10, 2018, by the San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission (Resolution No. RO18-09 et al.) ordering the reorganization affecting the Julian-Cuyamaca Fire Protection District and County Service Area No. 135 and providing for the dissolution of the Julian-Cuyamaca Fire Protection District, the expansion of County Service Area No. 135's existing latent powers in the affected territory, and designating County Service Area No. 135 as the successor agency to the dissolved district be confirmed subject to the terms and conditions specified in the order?

2. WHO CAN VOTE IN THIS ELECTION?

All registered voters in the Julian-Cuyamaca Fire Protection District are eligible to vote.

3. WHEN IS THE DEADLINE TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN THIS ELECTION?

March 4, 2019 is the deadline to register to vote in this election. You will need to re-register when you move, change your name or change your political party. You can register online at sdvote.com. Voter registration forms are also available at the Post Office, Department of Motor Vehicles and library buildings, as well as various City Clerk offices and the Registrar of Voters office at 5600 Overland Ave, San Diego 92123. If you miss the deadline to register, you may register conditionally and vote a provisional ballot at the Registrar's office.

4. WHAT IS A CONDITIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION?

If you do not register to vote by the March 4th deadline, you may still conditionally register and cast a provisional ballot. To do that, you must visit the San Diego County Registrar of Voters office during the 14 days before the election or on Election Day. Once your voter registration is processed and determined to be eligible, your registration becomes permanent. Then the provisional ballot you cast can be counted. [Learn more.](#)

5. WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY BALLOT?

On February 19, 2019, a ballot packet will be mailed to voters in the district. This packet will contain an official ballot, Voter Information Pamphlet and an envelope for returning the ballot to the Registrar of Voters Office. Ballot packets will also be mailed to those who register to vote before the close of registration for this election on March 4, 2019. Voters may also vote at the Office of the Registrar of Voters beginning Tuesday, February 19th through Election Day (Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.; and on Election Day 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.). Any mail ballot postmarked by Election Day and received by the Registrar of Voters no later than three days after Election Day will be deemed timely cast.

It is NOT necessary to apply for a mail ballot for this election. A ballot will automatically be sent to every eligible voter.
