

# SIGN, SEAL & RETURN YOUR MAIL BALLOT TO A TRUSTED SOURCE!



## SIGN

Once you've voted your mail ballot, date and sign your own name on the back of your return envelope. Sign your name just like it appears on your driver's license or identification card.

**Do not print. Use black or blue ink only.**

Your signature is as unique as you are. Registrar of Voters staff compare the signature on your return envelope against the signature from when you registered to vote. This comparison is done before counting your ballot.

**Your signature is required for your vote to count!**



## SEAL & RETURN

Seal your completed ballot in your postage paid envelope and return it promptly so it is received well before Election Day.

**Return your ballot to a trusted source:**

- By mail, at any USPS mailbox
- You may also return your mail ballot at one of the Registrar's 126 convenient drop-off locations around the county.
