This special primary election is to fill the vacant seat in the County's First Supervisorial District for the remainder of the current term ending in January 2029. Only voters residing in the First Supervisorial District are eligible to participate in the election.

Every active registered voter residing in the First Supervisorial District will receive a ballot in the mail **the week of March 10**, giving you plenty of time to return your ballot before **April 8**.

## Here are your voting options:

- You can complete your ballot in the comfort of your home and return it through the U.S.
   Postal Service. Your signature is required for your vote to count!
- **Starting Tuesday, March 11,** you'll have the additional option of dropping off your ballot at one of 29 official ballot drop boxes located around the district.
- If you would rather vote in person, that option is available too. Avoid long lines by taking advantage of early voting!
  - **Starting Saturday, March 29,** seven vote centers will be open daily from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. until the final day of voting on Tuesday, April 8, when thirteen vote centers will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
