MARCH 10

Early voting begins at the Registrar's office: Monday - Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

MARCH 11

29 official ballot drop boxes throughout the district are open 24 hours a day until 8 p.m. on Election Day, April 8.

MARCH 24

Voter registration deadline.

MARCH 25

If you missed the voter registration deadline, you can still conditionally register and vote by visiting the Registrar's office or any vote center in the district through Election Day, April 8.

MARCH 29

Seven vote centers open daily from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. through April 8. Avoid long lines and vote early!

APRIL 8

<u>Last day to vote!</u> 13 vote centers and 29 official ballot drop boxes are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. throughout the district.

8 YAM

Deadline to certify the election.

*Certification may occur on an earlier date.

^{*}Only registered voters residing in the First Supervisorial District can vote in this election. If no candidate receives a majority vote in the primary election, the top two vote-getters will advance to the special general election on July 1, 2025.
