WHAT IS THE VOTER'S CHOICE ACT?

Under the Voter's Choice Act (VCA), you choose when, where, and how you vote. Elections are no longer a one-day event and there is no need to wait until Election Day to vote.

Every active registered voter in San Diego County will automatically receive a ballot in the mail nearly a month before Election Day. Once you receive your ballot, you can return it:

- By mail
- At an official Ballot Drop Box location
- At a Vote Center near you

WHY THE CHANGE?

The Voter's Choice Act is designed to make voting more convenient and accessible.

In October 2021, the County of San Diego Board of Supervisors approved the transition to the VCA model.

WHAT IS A VOTE CENTER?

Vote Centers replace polling places and provide more services to voters. You can vote in person at any Vote Center in San Diego County.

Some Vote Centers will be open 11 days, including Election Day, and all Vote Centers will be open 4 days, including Election Day.

MAIL

- Sign and date your return envelope, seal your ballot inside, and return it through the U.S. Postal Service – no stamp needed!
- Remember to sign your return envelope! Your signature is required for your mail ballot to count.

BALLOT DROP BOX

 Sign and date your return envelope, seal your ballot inside, and return it to any official ballot drop box location or Vote Center.

VOTE CENTER

- Vote in person at any Vote Center in San Diego County.
- Some Vote Centers will be open 11 days, including Election Day. All Vote Centers will be open 4 days, including Election Day.
- Other services available at Vote Centers:
 - Vote using an accessible ballot marking device
 - Receive voting assistance, including assistance in multiple languages
 - Register to vote or update your registration and vote on the same day
 - If you made a mistake or lost your mail ballot, you can instead vote at any Vote Center
