



## Public Notice

In-office voting for the Nov. 7, 2023, Special Election begins Monday, Oct. 9 at the [San Diego County Registrar of Voters](#) located at 5600 Overland Avenue, San Diego, CA, 92123 on the County Operations Center campus in Kearny Mesa.

- The Registrar's office will be open for voting Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. until the final day of voting, Nov. 7 when the voting hours change to 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Vote centers open for eleven days. Starting Saturday, Oct 28, select vote centers will be open daily from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. until the final day of voting, Nov. 7 when all vote centers are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Voting System Logic and Accuracy Testing:

- Starting Tuesday, Oct. 3 from 10am to 4pm, daily or until completed.

Processing of Mail Ballots:

- Signature verification of return envelopes is expected to begin Oct. 13.
- Opening and preparing mail ballots for tabulation is expected to begin Oct. 16.
- Ballot scanning and adjudication is expected to begin Oct. 27.

Voting results will be posted on the following schedule:

- After 8 p.m., Tuesday, Nov. 7 (following the close of vote centers, periodic result updates will continue throughout the night until all vote center ballots are reported).
- After election night, the next unofficial results update will be posted on the following schedule:
  - By 5 p.m., Thursday, Nov. 9.
  - By 5 p.m., Monday/Wednesday/Friday, Nov. 13 through Nov. 17.
- Additional postings may occur at the discretion of the Registrar of Voters.

Please note the office will be closed on Nov. 10 in observance of Veterans Day and Nov. 23 and 24 in observance of Thanksgiving.

All results are unofficial until completion of the official canvass of the election on or before Dec. 7.
