Mayor John McCann will lower our cost of living by stopping San Diego County's planned \$1 Billion in new taxes on our middle class and working families, fighting SANDAG's "mileage tax" on driving, and opposing tariffs.

Mayor McCann has decades of experience that have led to Chula Vista's current balanced budget without tax increases or cuts to city services.

Mayor McCann is law enforcement's choice and will keep our streets safe. McCann championed hiring hundreds of new Firefighters and Police Officers. McCann is endorsed by the San Diego County Deputy Sheriffs' Association, Chula Vista Police Officers Association and San Diego Police Officers Association.

Mayor McCann will get homeless off the streets by providing compassionate services, while protecting communities by supporting a strict homeless encampment ban.

Mayor McCann is leading the fight to repair the environmental damage caused by the Tijuana sewage pollution. McCann was instrumental in securing \$600 million in federal funding to upgrade the South Bay International Wastewater Treatment Plant.
