

The San Diego County Registrar of Voters created this social media toolkit to support voter education and outreach in the community for the First Supervisorial District, Special General Election.

This toolkit provides accurate and consistent messaging from a trusted source. This toolkit contains information and suggested messages for the **July 1, 2025**, **First Supervisorial District Special General Election**. All suggested messages and graphics are available for use on social media and websites.

### **Election Information**

This special general election is to fill the vacant seat in the County's First Supervisorial District for the remainder of the current term ending in January 2029.

Only voters living in the First Supervisorial District are eligible to participate in the election. Not sure if you live in the First Supervisorial District? **Find your district**.

Every active registered voter living in the First Supervisorial District will receive a ballot in the mail **the** week of June 2 for this special general election.

### Here are your voting options:

- You can complete your ballot in the comfort of your home and return it through the U.S. Postal
   Service. Your signature is required for your vote to count!
- Starting Tuesday, June 3, you'll have the option of dropping off your ballot at one of 29 official ballot drop boxes throughout the district.
- If you would rather vote in person, that option is available too. Take advantage of one of the ten days of early in-person voting!
  - Starting Saturday, June 21, seven vote centers will be open daily from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
     until the final day of voting on Tuesday, July 1, when thirteen vote centers will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

District 1 spans from the Pacific Ocean on the west, to the Otay and San Miguel mountains in the east, and from Barrio Logan in the north to the U.S./Mexico international border on the south. The First Supervisorial District includes the cities of Chula Vista, Imperial Beach, National City, and some communities within the City of San Diego, such as Barrio Logan, East Village, Golden Hill, and more. Additionally, District 1 includes the unincorporated areas of Bonita, East Otay Mesa, Lincoln Acres, Sunnyside, and La Presa.

- If you live in District 1 and want to vote in the July 1 special general election, you must register to vote by June 16 to receive a ballot in the mail. Ballots will start going out the week of June 2. Learn more at sdvote.com.

# **Voting by Mail Messages (starting June 2)**

- District 1 voters: you don't have to wait until Election Day to vote! Don't delay, return

### <u>Vote Early Messages</u> (June 21 – June 30, seven vote centers open daily from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.)
