Public observation of ballot processing activities will be at the San Diego County Registrar of Voters located at 5600 Overland Avenue, Suite 100, San Diego, CA, 92123 on the County Operations Center campus in Kearny Mesa. - **Ballot Scanning:** Begins Fri., May 22
- **Ballot Adjudication:** Begins Mon., May 25
- **Provisional Ballot Processing:** Begins Mon., June 8 (post-election)

- **Manual Tally:** Begins Tue., June 9 at 9 a.m.
- The Manual Tally will then continue each day, until completed, Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Manual Tally hours may be extended, including evenings until 8 p.m. and/or on weekends and holidays.

ELECTION RESULTS POSTING SCHEDULE

- After 8 p.m., Tuesday, June 2 (following the close of vote centers, periodic result updates will continue throughout the night until all vote center ballots are reported).
- After election night, the next unofficial results update will be posted on the following schedule:
 - By 6 p.m., Thursday, June 4 through Friday, June 5
 - By 6 p.m., Monday, June 8
 - Please note, additional updates will occur at the discretion of the Registrar of Voters with the date of the next posting prominently displayed at sdvote.com on the unofficial results bulletin.

All results are unofficial until completion of the official canvass of the election on or before July 2.

The Registrar's office will be closed on June 19 in observance of Juneteenth.
