One Percent Manual Tally for the California Gubernatorial Recall Election September 14, 2021

Pursuant to State Law, during the official canvass of every election in which a voting system is used, a public manual tally of ballots tabulated by those devices shall be conducted.

A manual tally of ballots cast in at least 1% of precincts and batches, selected at random, will be conducted as part of the post-Election Day canvass of this election. The manual tally process, as are all components of the official canvass of results, is open to public observation.

The random selection of precincts and batches to be manually tallied will commence on:
Thursday, September 16, at 2:00 p.m.

The manual tally of the votes cast on these selected ballots will commence on:
Tuesday, September 21, at 9:00 a.m.

The manual tally will be conducted each day, until completed, during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. If needed, manual tally hours could be extended, including evenings until 8:00 p.m. and/or on weekends and holidays.
